## STEP 1: Gather your materials

### Materials:

- blank paper for sketching out ideas
- Thicker paper like cardstock for your paper puppet
- Something to color with like colored pencils, markers, crayons, or paints
- Scissors
- Hole puncher
- Brass fasteners

### Alternate Materials:

- Paper clip to make a hole
- Twist ties, string, or wire to fasten
- Tape to stick alternate fasteners to the paper

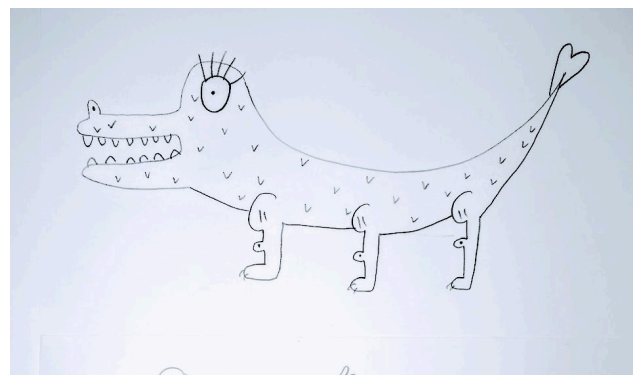
## STEP 2: Come up with an idea for a character and sketch it out.

What can you come up with?

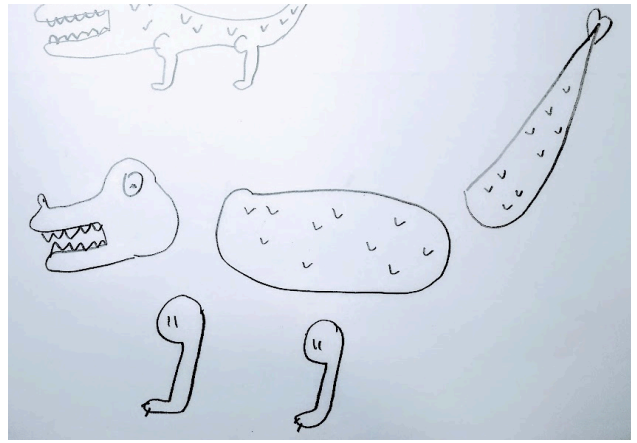


### STEP 3: Divide your character into parts.

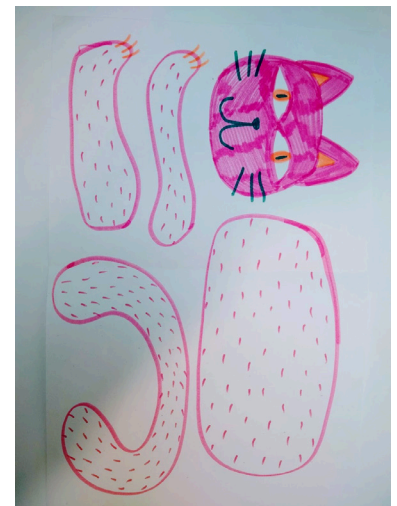
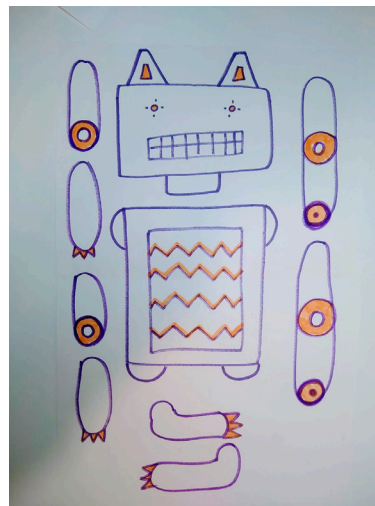
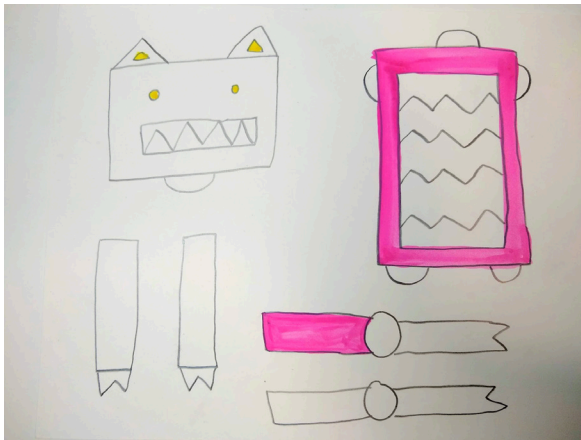
Figure out how to divide your character into different parts that can move and begin sketching out those pieces.

### STEP 6: Fasten your pieces together.

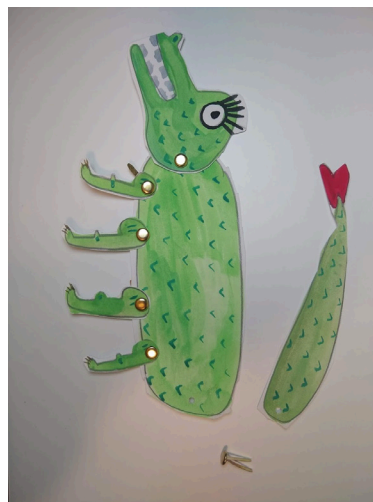

#### Included in your kit:

- Hole puncher + brass fasteners (6:20)

#### Alternatively:

- Twist tie fastener + paper clip hole + masking tape (6:52)
- String fastener + paper clip hole + masking tape (8:58)
- Wire + paper clip hole + masking tape (10:50)
